The various obstacles include the Water Tunnel, where you are completely submerged and unable to move yourself, relying on one Royal Marine to push you in and another to pull you out again, and the Peat Bog, which is just plain disgusting - waist deep in places and just pure black sludge - the Royal Marines make sure that no-one leaves the Peat Bog without having a good working over! The Crocodile Pit is a deep muddy trench, which takes teamwork to get everyone out of and Peters Pool is a lake of freezing cold water. After all of that they have a full decontamination unit in which to hose everyone down!

Gemma said: “It was great fun. I can't wait to do it again next year - everyone should go commando!”
