Hennings Moir supports local charity as part of birthday celebrations

In celebration of its 10th birthday, Hennings Moir, **team** estate agent in Saltash has decided to support local charity, Horizons, which provides boating activities for financially and socially disadvantaged children as well as children with physical and mental disabilities.



Run by a band of enthusiastic volunteers, the children's sailing charity makes sailing available to young people in Plymouth, many who live near the water but owing to financial, social or physiological disadvantages, have no safe access to it.

Based on the Mayflower International Marina with full disabled facilities including wide pontoons and ramps for easy wheelchair access, Horizons provides the children with the opportunity to experience going afloat in both power boats, adapted for wheelchair users, and sailing craft giving the children learning and educational opportunities that increase self-confidence and improve social and practice skills. It also develops their awareness of local history and the maritime environment through the experience of water-based activities, usually beyond their means.

Hennings Moir will support the charity in a number of ways – not only with fundraising events and collection tins in the office – the team of management and staff will be helping out on the water as volunteers.

Steve Moir, partner of Hennings Moir and chairman of Westcountry team, said: "Ian and I had to do something to celebrate Henning Moir's anniversary! We are really pleased to support the charity, and we're proud that everyone in the office wants to be involved too. We hope that other agents in the **team** network will join us. Later next year, we will be organising a day for **team** agents in Devon and Cornwall to come along, have a day out and support the charity - as long as they bring their children along!"
